Why? (Aim / Mission)

For so many years, we have been receiving enquires like "I am a house wife and I want to learn about Interior Design. I can't go to College full - time for 3 - 5 years." OR "I am studying B.Com / B.A. / B.Sc. / Physiotherapy / Post Graduation etc. Can I also learn Interior Designing, side by side?" Keeping such demands in focus and

researching for 3 years, we have worked out a compact program which will help the candidates to develop the necessary skills, aptitude and attitude towards Interior Design.

How? (Syllabus)

The journey is a fusion of three aspects: Skills, aptitude and attitude.

Skills: If you can imagine / Visualize some design, it is very important that you have the skills of representing it in some visual form. So here is what we will develop in you:

- (1) Drawing Skills :- Line Drawing, Object Drawing, One Point / Two Point, Three Point Perspective, Memory Drawing, Site Sketching, etc.
- (2) Shading: Shading in sixteen shades of gray scale.
- (3) Colors: Moods of Colors, Nature of Colors, Color Psychology, Color Charts using the primary colors, black, white, gold & silver. Sketch and color.
- (4) Mode Making Skills: Making models out of mount board, Thermocol and potters clay.
- (5) Other Skills :- We will also learn making collages and graffiti. Which will help us understand human psychology and behavior. We need to know this because "We always design for humans."

Aptitude: Designing is a never ending process. "Once a student, always a student." This statement holds true for this "Way of Life." How do designers think, what do they observe, how do they dress - up, how do they communicate..... We will learn all this by doing a lot of site visits and market interaction.

Attitude:- Out of all the people I have met in my life, every body wants to be successful but everyone is not. Why ??? Because "Everyone wants heaven but who is willing to die?" We have deviced some games and group discussions which will enable you to evaluate your current attitude. If it is upto the mark; Congratulations. And if not, we will quide you how to CHANGE.

How Long? (Duration)

This is a 6 months program, deviced for a very convenient timings. Two hours a day, three days a week. Please Contact the co-ordinator, for batch timings.

At the end, an exam will be conducted. The qualifying candidates will be issued a certificate.

For Whom? (Eligibility)

Any one who has passed 10th.

OR

Anyone who is 18 years or more of age.

For How much? (Fees)

The fees is Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) inclusive of taxes.
